I. **Call to Order**

Chairman Frank Gallo called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m.

II. **Public Comment**

Gallo asked for public comment and/or Board comment, seeing none he moved on.

III. **Approval of ADLA Board Meeting Minutes**

Gallo called for approval of the minutes from March 2024. Normandin motioned to approve the minutes, which were seconded by Bhavnani. At 1:33 p.m., the minutes were approved unanimously.

IV. **Public Safety Report**

Gallo asked for the public safety report, but seeing as Officer Zambrano was not present, Gallo moved on.

V. **Presentations**

Gallo asked for presentations. Chris Cashman introduced himself and his organization, Atypical IT, which provides I.T. solutions. Chris asked Vargas to share his contact information with the Board in case anyone needed IT solutions. Gallo thanked Cashman and moved onto the next presentation.

Cullin Tobin introduced himself and presented his campaign centered around educating neighbors to pick up after their dogs. He expressed concerns about dog waste becoming a hindrance to our neighborhood. Tobin proposed installing signs to remind community members to pick up after their pets. Bhavnani asked how much this campaign would cost. Tobin responded that he would like to install 50 signs which would cost \$3,000. Phillips suggested getting community support for funding. Mitchell commented that, in her experience, signs are often tagged, stickered, or stolen. She recommended either reducing the size of the signs or stenciling it on the sidewalk. Vargas announced that anyone interested in being involved can attend the next neighborhood council meeting. He explained the community will be working on this for a few months. Gallo thanked Tobin and moved on.

VI. **Artist Report**

Gallo asked for an artist report, but seeing none he moved on.

VII. LARABA Update

Gallo asked for a LARABA update. Javier Borrani, LARABA President, shared that Bridgefest LA would be happening again this year. He said the event will be co-produced this year with Insomniac and that they hope to organize the event in September. Phillips asked whether the bridge lights would be working before then. Borrani explained that it would be unlikely because the wiring is expensive to replace, but there will be additional lighting from the production company.

VIII. New Business

Gallo asked for new business, but seeing no comments, he moved on.

Gallo concluded the meeting at 1:48 p.m.
