### BALLOT TABULATION RESULTS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ARTS DISTRICT LOS ANGELES DISTRICT PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (CF NO. 23-0391)

**SECTION 1.** Results of the Proposition 218 ballot tabulation, pursuant to Article XIII D of the California Constitution, Section 36600 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code, and Section 53753 of the California Government Code:

	Ballots Cast	Weighted Value	Percent of Ballots Cast
Supporting ("Yes") ballots:	191	\$537,960.58	83.678%
Opposing ("No") ballots:	38	\$104,933.81	16.322%

On Tuesday, June 20, 2023, the City Clerk's office tabulated ballots in the

election for the Arts District Business Improvement District. With an approval of 84%, the Arts District BID was reestablished. On June 28th, the City Council certified the election results and voted to adopt an ordinance establishing the Arts District BID for another seven years.



Many thanks to every one who signed a petition, mailed-in their ballot and / or reminded their neighbors to vote.
