



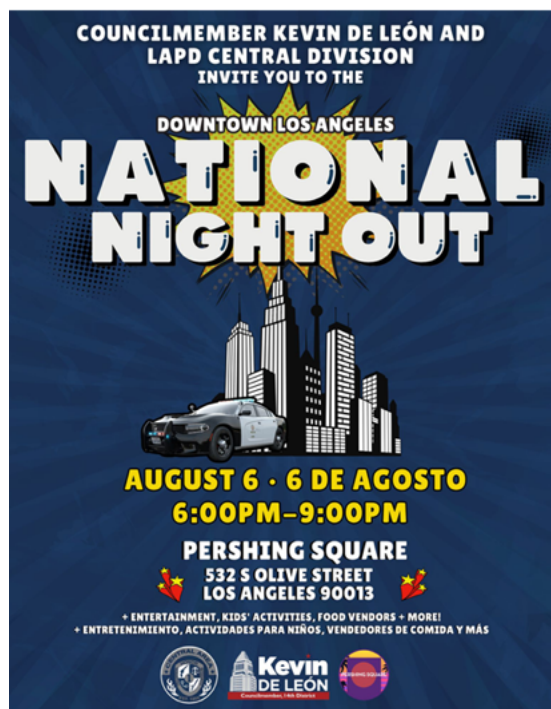
The Aliso Tree

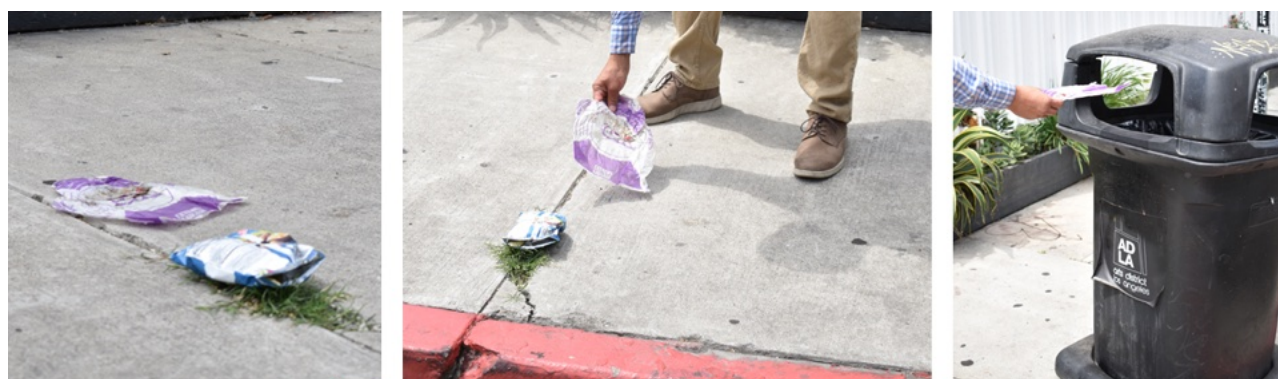
National Night Out is an annual event where communities across the country
