Curb Management Survey

Last-Mile, Delivery and Ride-hail Drives + Local Businesses



A coalition of partners--spanning nonprofits, academia, startups and local government--in the cities of Pittsburgh, Santa Monica and Los Angeles are working to accelerate electric vehicle (EV) adoption for last-mile deliveries. Funded by the U.S. Department of Energy, the partners are working to deploy technology to support cities in understanding how drivers are utilizing commercial loading zones (including smart loading zones and zero emission delivery zones).

To support intervention and modeling design for these efforts, the partners are working to better understand the current status of delivery driver, food driver, Transportation Network Company (TNC) drivers and other cars for hire, and their utilization of the curb. This survey is intended to support the design of interventions, modeling, incentives and parking enforcement to support the needs of last-mile transportation and delivery drivers while supporting city governments in meeting their transportation and climate-based goals. 
